Our online PSEO program offers asynchronous courses in dynamic virtual classrooms utilizing a user-friendly learning management system. We offer a large selection of core curriculum courses taught by credentialed faculty.

SCHOLARSHIPS

A Crown PSEO Scholarship is available to students who attend Crown PSEO and then enroll as full-time first-year students the following academic year. The maximum amount of this scholarship is \$500 per year if attending on campus.

A Crown Christian High School Partner Grant of \$2,000 per year is available to students who enroll as full-time first-year students and who attended a partner Christian High School institution or a homeschool/PSEO Crown partner.

The Crown PSEO Scholarship and the Christian High School Partner Grant are renewable and stackable. Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress to renew their scholarship.

Students may also qualify for additional aid. Students must demonstrate financial need as determined by the FAFSA.

Students enrolling in an online degree program are eligible for a 25% off tuition discount.
